## **DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, <u>WEATHER</u> STORM WARNING FOR THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA, THREATENING POWER OUTAGES, AND UNSAFE DRIVING CONDITIONS; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described emergency, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the Town of Liberty, North Carolina under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 34 of the Code of Liberty:

- <u>Section 1.</u> A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the Town of Liberty as more particularly described in Section 2.

<u>Section 4.</u> I hereby order all Town of Liberty law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the Town of Liberty Emergency Operations Plan.

Section 5. I hereby order this Declaration to be distributed and/or filed as follows: (a) The Declaration is to be distributed to the news media and other organizations in a manner calculated to bring the Declaration's contents to the attention of the general public; (b) The Declaration is to be filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Liberty, North Carolina; and (c) The Declaration is to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of the said instrument.

<u>Section 6.</u> This Declaration is set to start **January 9, 2024** at **9:00 AM**, and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.

**THIS DECLARATION** is issued at 9:00 AM on the 9th day of JANUARY 2024 in the Town of Liberty, NC.
